The Vaccines For Children Program (VFC)

What is VFC?

VFC is a federally funded program that provides vaccines free of charge to children.

Who is eligible?

Any child younger than 19 years of age who is:

- American Indian or Alaskan Native
- Eligible for Medicaid
- Underinsured (only at Federally Qualified Health Centers or Rural Health Clinics)
- Uninsured

Are the vaccines really free?

- There is no cost for the actual vaccine
- Healthcare providers can ask for a fee for giving the vaccine, but you have the right to say you cannot afford it and do NOT have to pay

Know Your Rights!

Children cannot be denied a vaccine based on their immigration status.
